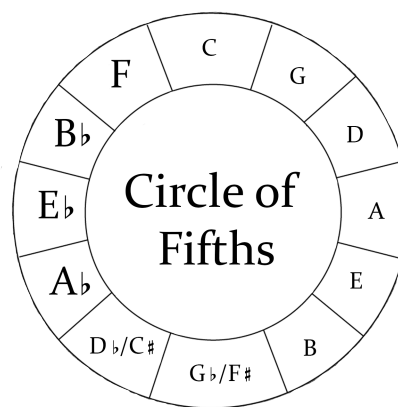


Scales and Chords Set 3 (no key signatures)
